BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

1. Be respectful to the teacher and other students.
"Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another." 1 John 4:11
2. Treat others the way you want to be treated.
"And as you wish that others would do to you, do so to them." Luke 6:31
3. Use kind words
"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23
4. Leave the area better than you found it.
"The earth is the LORD's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein." Psalms 24:1

Appropriate behavior is defined as a co-operative spirit on the part of the child.

Inappropriate behavior is defined as defiant, disruptive, or harmful behavior to oneself or others. Inappropriate behavior will be addressed by a children's ministry leader and will be handled in a manner as outlined in the **Discipline Policy**.

Discipline Plan

1st offense – verbal warning

The child will be separated from other children and verbally made aware of the inappropriate behavior by a children's ministry leader. The leader will clearly define how to alter the behavior so that it is acceptable

2nd offense – Time-out

The leader will separate the child from the class. The teacher will remind the child of the inappropriate behavior. The child will then be required to sit separate from the class, but in full view of the teacher for a period of 4-5 minutes.

3rd offense – Speak with Director or parents notified

Parent Involvement

Parent Notification

The Director will determine whether or not a parent needs to be notified during service, after the service (at pick-up) or via phone call later in the day. Our goal is to talk to the parent in a private location, in person and after the service when possible. Parents will be notified every time a child's behavior results in their removal from standard activities.

Attention Parents!

Placing your child into any of the Children's Ministries at Daniels Road Baptist Church signifies your acceptance of this discipline policy. Only discipline outlined in this policy may be administered as deemed necessary by the children's ministry workers.

***Severe misconduct (resulting in parents being notified during the service) is defined as:

1. Behavior that puts the child or another person in immediate danger.
2. Behavior that causes disruption to the point where the class cannot continue
